Challenger Learning Center Space Mission

We will be visiting the Challenger Learning Center in Lockport for a Simulated Space Mission and Planetarium viewing activity on April 10th. This activity is perfect timing for those working on the Space Exploration or Astronomy Merit Badges and for Scouts interested in the recent landing on Mars.

They will be offering our Scouts a Space themed simulation-based mission in a fully immersive Space Station and Mission Control.

Surrounded by technology, each Scout plays a unique role in the mission as the team completes assignments, manipulates hands-on labs, and copes with simulated emergencies. Teamwork is crucial, if one member fails to complete a job, the entire mission can be put at risk. This differentiated approach allows for a truly personalized learning experience where students apply critical, scientific knowledge to real-world scenarios.

This activity will take about 3 hours (plus a little more for review of the Space Exploration and Astronomy Merit Badge requirements).

The Cost for this activity is \$18.50. We have 14 Scouts registered for this event.
