It is filling up fast. Cost is \$10.

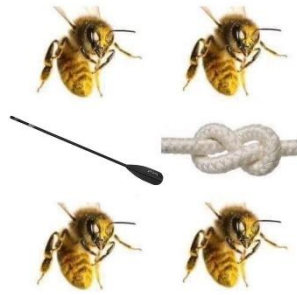
