To clarify – The popcorn buy out fee is \$100. This has nothing to do with your yearly dues.


Remind messaging — Our Troop also uses the REMIND messenger to relay information. Please make sure you are signed up to receive messages.

Popcorn This year our Troop will be selling popcorn as a fund raising activity.
