Work will continue on the two merit badges this week.

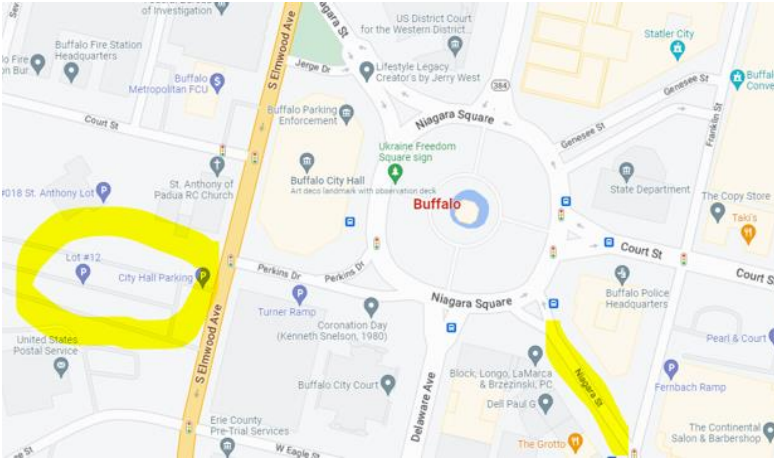
Scouts not working on the Game Design/Animation merit badges must work with Evelyn on the Sports merit badge or work on rank advancements with a senior Scout or an Adult.
