Total cost per Scout is \$555. Adults are \$200.

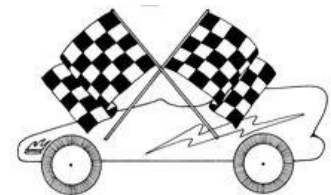

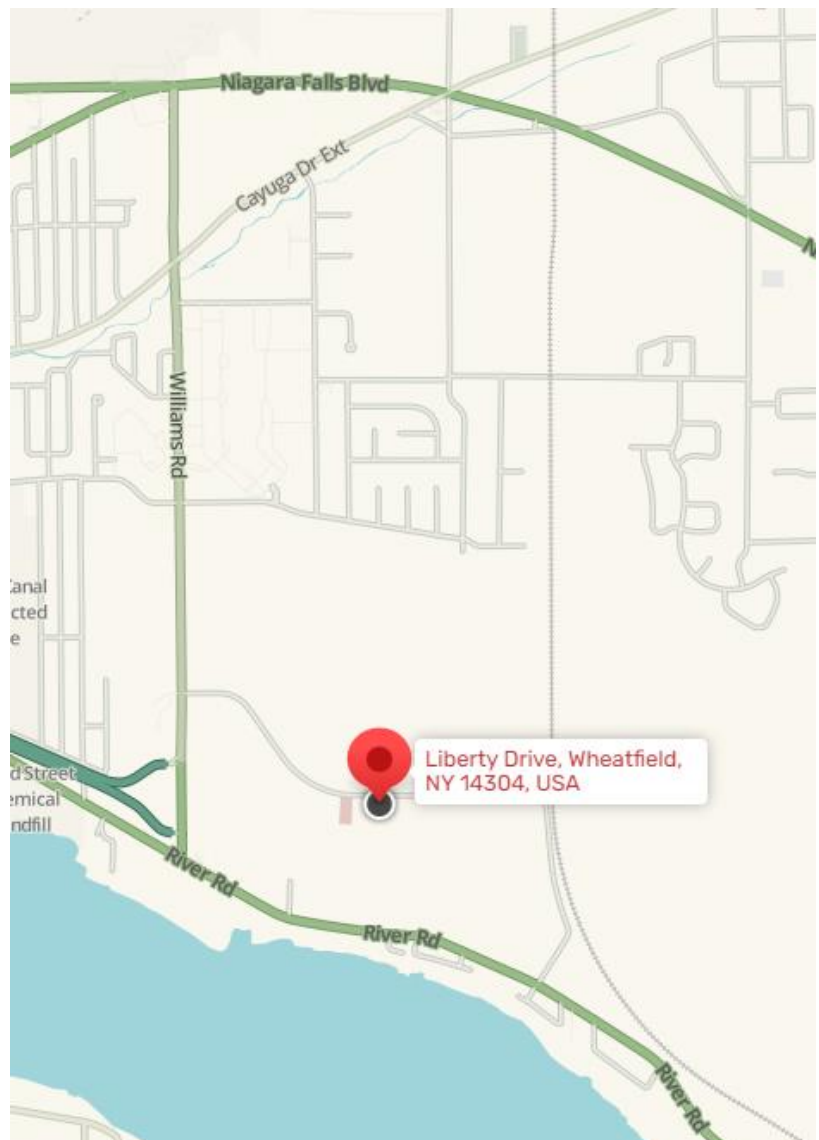


Conservation Service Project – Liberty Drive Clean up
